Criteria for SNA E-competitions

1. E - Scientific Paper Presentation

Theme: Prevalence of COVID - Appropriate Behavior among general public

E - Scientific paper presentation refers to electronic visual version of research paper with a brief description of the methods, tables and/or graphs related to the findings, and interpretation of the data.

Criteria for Scientific Paper Presentation-Individual/Group Competition

The Student Nurse(s) will present the Scientific Paper on the theme.

- i. The paper should contain: Introduction, Need, Significance in Nursing, Statement of the Problem, Objectives, Review of Literature, Methodology, Findings and Interpretation (with one or two tables), Recommendation, Implications, Conclusion and Bibliography.
- ii. One hard copy and one soft copy of the Scientific Paper containing not more than 1500 words (4-5 pages in A-4 size) which should be submitted to the State SNAI Advisor.
- iii. The State SNAI Advisor along with the committee members will select up to three best Scientific Papers at the State Level which shall be presented by the student(s) during the state SNAI conference.
- iv. One e scientific paper per Unit.

2. E - Poster Presentation-Individual Competition

E - Poster presentation refers to an electronic way of exhibition of the topic in pictorial form with short and concise outline of the concept.

- ii) Section 3-9 are for GNM/ B.Sc Nursing Students.
- iii) Section 10-11 are for all categories of (ANM/GNM/B.Sc.) Nursing students.
- iv) Hand -made posters uploaded digitally will be considered.

b) Criteria for E-Poster Presentation

- i. **Size:** Standard size (22"x26") approx. for both individual and group presentation.
- ii. **Topics:** Ideas depicted in the poster should be relevant to the topics given. Font size and design of letters should be bold and clearly visible.
- iii. Clarity: For bringing clarity of the poster, restrict yourself to one idea relevant to the topic.
- iv. Layout of pictures: It must be balanced to give a correct sense of proportion.
- v. **No extra fixing:** of clippings/cuttings or any other form on the poster.
- vi. Legibility: The poster should be easy to read.

- vii. **Quality of picture:** The key concepts of the poster should be diagrammatically represented. Ideally it should have a single figure representing the entire concept. Figures should be neatly labeled.
- viii. **Flow:** The poster content should follow a logical sequence. The reader should be able to navigate the poster with ease.
- ix. Poster must be free of spelling mistakes.
- x. The poster should be original with some innovative idea.
- xi. One entry per section per unit.

3. ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION-Group Competition

Quiz competition on various Nursing subjects including General Knowledge can be conducted through Quiziz.

- Each S.N.A.Unit team consist of three students.
- · Kindly send three students entries per unit.
- a) Components of Quiz Competition:
 - i. General knowledge
 - ii. General awareness regarding nursing
 - iii. Sports
 - iv. Literature
 - v. History and culture
 - vi. Entertainment

Note: Video or pictures can be included in any of the rounds.

- b) General Instructions:
 - i. Quiz comprises of 8 rounds with a total of 50 questions.
 - ii. The rounds are Acronym Corner, Close the Loop Holes, Track the Fame Days, Truth Or Dare, Emoji Nation Guess Me, Quizalize, Ping on Colors, Unwrap The Covid Fire.
 - iii. Each round has 5 questions except quizalize which has 15 questions.
 - iv. Each question carries 1 mark. No negative scores.
 - v. Scoring will be displayed through the Quiz Application.
 - vi. State level quiz competition will be held on 26th October 2021.

4. CONCEPT MAPPING-Individual Competition

Theme: SNA member to National TNAI President

Concept mapping refers to a diagram or graphical tool that visually represents relationships between concepts and ideas.

Criteria for concept writing:

- i. **Logical**: All the relevant concepts must be well organized and linked logically. Concepts reflect the essential information about the topic.
- ii. Design: Text should be clear and easy to read. Amount of text is appropriate for the intended audience. Color should be effectively used for emphasis and increased comprehension. Graphics are used only when necessary.
- iii. Layout: Map must be contained in a single page.
- iv. **Hierarchy:** The number of hierarchical levels addresses the degree of categorization of concept with relevant examples.
- v. **Use of descriptive links:** Concepts are physically arranged, so links are established in the most reasonable way, without cluttering the map. All concepts must be interlinked with other plotted concepts.

All the entries should be emailed to> snaimaha2021@gmail.com.< Along with duly filled competition entry form. It should reach by 15thOctober 2021.

- Please read the rules carefully and accordingly instruct the student to prepare for the competitions.
- The best entry will be nominated to National level, where it will be evaluated on the same criteria.
- Any entry not fulfilling the criteria will be debarred.
