About Mumbai



Mumbai, the capital city of Maharashtra is called the “city of dreams” or “Mayanagri”. Mumbai is the financial, commercial and the entertainment capital of India. It is built on seven islands: Isle of Bombay, Parel, Mazagaon, Mahim, Colaba, Worli, and Old Woman's Island (also known as Little Colaba). Mumbai's culture offers a blend of traditional and cosmopolitan festivals, food, entertainment, and night life. The city's cosmopolitan and urban-centric modern cultural offerings are comparable to other world capitals. The city is also home

to Bollywood and Marathi cinema industries. Mumbai's business opportunities attract migrants from all over India.

Marine Drive situated on reclaimed land facing west-south-west, also known as the Queen's Necklace as the street lights resemble a string of pearls in a necklace when viewed from elevated point.



About Matunga



Matunga formed a part of the seven original islands of Mumbai with Mahim, then known as Mahikavati. It is said that the King of Mahikavati had his elephant stables in Matunga, and that the name Matunga was derived from "Matanga", the Sanskrit word for Elephant. Matunga was among the first well planned localities of Mumbai. The Dadar-Matunga-Wadala-Sion plan was formulated to evenly distribute population as well as provide better living standards.

Matunga has a colourful flower market, especially known for the south Indian essence with Madras malli and Bangalore malli flowers that come from Tamil Nadu and rajamalli, mogra, champa, chameli and marigold, sourced from Vasai- Virar.



Matunga has numerous temples, namely, the Astika Samajam, the South Indian Bhajan Samaj, Sri Sankara Matham, Sri Kanyaka Parmeshwari Temple, The Church of Mary, Help of Christians (also known as Don Bosco Church), the Jain temples in Kings Circle and the Marubai Temple.

How to reach Matunga: - Matunga is well connected by road, rail and air with other cities of Maharashtra. Visanji Ravji Auditorium, Shree Ravji Jivraj Changdaiwala Hall in Matunga East, Mumbai is about 2.5 kms away from the Matunga railway station, the Mumbai airport is about 15 kms from the venue. The Trained Nurses' Association of India (TNAI) had its beginning in the Association of Nursing Superintendents which was founded in 1905, Lucknow (UP, India), composed of nine European Nurses holding administrative posts in hospitals. They saw the need to develop nursing as a profession and also to provide a forum where professional nurses could meet and plan to achieve these ends. The movement gathered momentum and in 1908, a decision was taken to establish the Trained Nurses' Association with the objective of:

1. Upholding in every way the dignity and honour of Nursing profession
2. Promoting a sense of esprit de corps among all Nurses
3. To advance professional, educational, economic and general welfare of nurses

IV) Poster Presentation (based on Scientific Paper)

All posters should be based on Research papers like a visual presentation of the scientific paper on any nursing specialty by individual TNAI member for display.

- a) Size: Size of the Poster/ Flex should be approximately 30*40 inches.
- b) Lettering: Lettering and design of the poster should be bold and big enough to be seen from a distance.
- c) Layout: Layout of the picture, if any, must be properly balanced to give a correct sense of proportion.

Note: 1) Ideas depicted in the poster should be relevant to the study.

2) Extra fixing of clipping/cuttings or any other form on the poster should be avoided.

3) The scientific study submitted for poster presentation shall follow IMRAD format (Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion)
