Also he had given indepth description about the various articles of discriminations

Speaker had explained about various crime happens against women in practical aspects and what are the safety measures can be taken to avoid it. 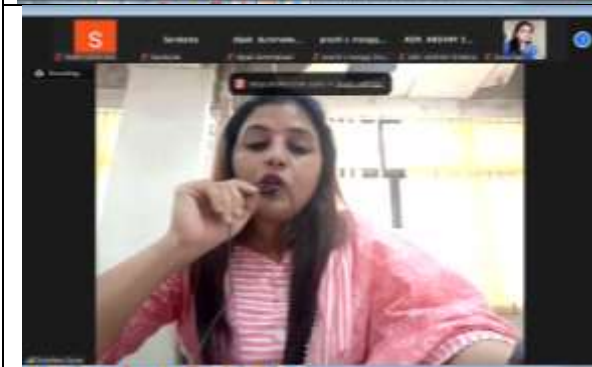
