We are delighted to inform you that House of Official Representatives (HOR), Associate House of Representatives (AHOR) meeting will be held along with 79th TNAI National Conference 2026. The General body meeting of the HOR and AHOR held in once in 2 years. This present venue was decided in 115th EC & CL Meeting.

The schedule for the meeting is given below:

Date: 14th December, 2026 (Monday)

Time: 09:00 am onwards

Venue: PST Hall, Ramoji Film City, Anaspur Village, Hayathnagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, Hyderabad, Telangana – 501512.

As per the decision of National Executive Committee, vide Minute No. TNAI/EC-11 & 12 April, 2026/9: All House of Representative (HOR)/AHOR **must complete conference registration** in order to participate in the HOR/AHOR Meeting.

- HOR consists of one representative for **every five hundred members**.
- AHOR consists of one representative for **every hundred members**.

In this connection kindly note that the calculation and fixation of the House of Official Representatives (Life Member of TNAI) & Associate House of Official Representatives (ANM & LHV) is based on TNAI Membership status as on **March 31, 2026 05:00 PM**.

The total number of HORs and AHORs allocated to each State/UT, based on its membership strength, is provided in Annexure I.

The agenda for the meeting of the HOR & AHOR shall include: The decisions which are taken by the Council shall be ratified by the HOR and AHOR. All issues referred by the Council shall be discussed and decisions shall be taken by the HOR and AHOR. It includes the Biennial Report, Biennial Accounts, Biennial Budget, Ratification of the decisions taken by the EC and Council, amendments to the Constitution and bye-laws, dealing with Policy matters and adoption of Policy and Position Statements and election of the office bearers of the TNAI.

Selection of House of Official Representatives (HOR) and Associate House of Official Representative (AHOR)

As per the TNAI Constitution Rules & Regulation and Bye-Laws. Page No. 37 to 41 Clause No. 13.

a. Eligibility

- The **HOR** shall be a Life Member of TNAI who is actively involved in TNAI activities.
- The **Associate TNAI HOR** shall be an Associate Life Member of TNAI who is actively involved in TNAI activities.

b. Procedure for selection of HOR/AHOR:

- i. To have proper representation, the HOR/AHOR shall be selected from different regions of the state viz. City, Districts, and Institutions (inclusive of Education, Service and Public Health Nursing). ***In any case, not more than 20% of HOR or AHOR shall not be from one institution. HOR and AHOR lists shall be prepared with their both residential and official address (with designation).***
- ii. Aforesaid information regarding selection of HOR/AHOR shall be widely published by the Branch President and Secretary through State branch website, circular letters, emails and personal communication to Zones, Districts, City, Institutions (inclusive of Education, Service and Public Health Nursing).
- iii. A special General Body meeting of the State/ UT branch shall be convened to select the HOR of the branch. An intimation in this regard shall be given with a minimum two weeks' notice period indicating the venue, date and time. The list of HOR/AHOR shall be prepared with additional 50% as waiting list.



- iv. The list of HOR/AHOR shall be prepared with Name, TNAI number, Date of Birth, Address with pin code, Phone number and Email ID with both official and residential address and designation as per the Performa given by TNAI Headquarters.
- v. The approved final list along with waiting list shall be signed by the State branch President and Secretary and sent to TNAI headquarters **on or before 14th September, 2026.**
- vi. Any substitution or changes in the final list of HOR/AHOR must be confirmed 3 days before the Meeting. Replacement can be made only from the waiting list. Written information with the signature of the President and Secretary of the State/UT branch will be required for the acceptance onto the final list.

Please Note: The list of selected HORs and AHORs, along with the waiting list, duly signed by the State Branch President and Secretary, should be submitted to TNAI Headquarters on or before 14 September 2026, in accordance with the allotted number for each State/UT.
