Dear Members,

Greetings from TNAI Headquarters!

We are delighted to inform you that National Student Nurses' Association (SNA) has completed 90 years and marching towards its centenary. Let us march forward with dedication, commitment and compassion.

The XXVIII SNA Biennial Conference will be held at the end of 2019. The hosting branch, venue and date will be informed to you later.

We request all SNA Unit and State branches to plan and work at unit and State Level competitions and wholeheartedly co-operate with the host branch to make it a grand success. Additional relevant information will appear periodically in the forthcoming issues of the Nursing Journal of India, TNAI Bulletin and TNAI website.

The theme of the Conference is: **"Nursing: Harmony of mind, body and spirit"**.

There is **no sub-theme** for the conference 2019.

A. Participation of SNA Delegates in SNA National Biennial Conference

- (i) Management of SNA:** The governing body of the SNA shall be the Council of TNAI which will receive the recommendations of the General Committee of the SNA Conference for consideration.

The SNA General Committee of SNA shall consist of:

- a) President of TNAI or one of the Vice Presidents if the President wishes to delegate this responsibility
- b) Secretary-General, TNAI
- c) Hony. Treasurer of TNAI
- d) National SNA Advisor who must be a Life member of TNAI
- e) State Branch SNA Advisors
- f) Vice-Presidents of SNA State branches (student)
- g) Secretaries of the SNA State branches (student)

The General Committee shall meet once in a year at the time of TNAI Council meeting. One-fifth or 15 members form a quorum.

They shall assist in the enrolment of student nurses to the SNA and the formation of SNA unit in every training centre and help student nurses to realize the importance of becoming Life members of TNAI on completion of their training.

(ii) SNA General Body

The SNA General body at the national level shall comprise of:

- a) Members of SNA General Committee
- b) Three representatives from each unit viz., SNA Vice President, SNA Secretary and SNA Advisor
- c) All SNA Delegates attending the conference
- d) One ANM student from each State (as an Associate member) since 2007.

The General Body Meetings: The General Body meeting of the Association shall be held at the time of the SNA Conference.

The President, TNAI shall preside over the SNA Meetings. SNA office bearers of the host branch shall conduct the SNA meetings along with the President.

Agenda items from the Branches should be sent to National SNA Advisor at least two months before the General Committee meeting.

Resolutions passed at the General committee and General Body meetings shall be forwarded by the National SNA Advisor of the Student Nurses Association to concerned authorities and TNAI Council for consideration. The action taken by the Council and other concerned authorities shall be forwarded by the National SNA Advisor of the Student Nurses Association to the State SNA Vice-Presidents, Secretaries and the State Branch SNA Advisors.

Nominate representatives from your State / Unit SNA, who would be able to take part in discussions and participate in all the meetings, sessions and functions and contribute valuably. The representative chosen by you should be well informed of the Unit activities to present a clear and concise report, and be one who could give a good report to the Branch/Unit on return. The representatives (delegates) should be thoroughly conversant with the SNA Rules & Regulations and Byelaws, etc., to be able to contribute and take part in various issues discussed.

(iii) Agenda Items

All the State SNA Advisors are requested to send the agenda items to the National SNA Advisor after discussing with the Branch President and Secretary. The agenda items should have only issues of national level. State SNA Advisors who are sending agenda items should be present during the General Committee meeting with adequate information related to the agenda items. Otherwise the agenda will not be discussed at the meeting. The Agenda items from the State SNA Advisors should reach TNAI Headquarters by October 31, 2019.

(iv) SNA Biennial Reports

Each Branch is expected to present the State SNA Biennial Report during the Business Session. The Branch report should be presented briefly through power point presentation; every state shall be given 5 minutes to present the report. Soft copy and hard copy of the report to be sent to TNAI Headquarters by October 31, 2019.

Note: The branches who send the State SNA Biennial report to the Headquarters are only allowed to present State Branch report during the Conference.

(v) State SNA Biennial Best Performance Award

The State SNA performance is also evaluated at the national level for selecting the Best SNA Branch. State SNA Biennial Best Performance Award is given based on the State SNA Biennial Report. In this regard we will be sending a proforma, which is to be duly filled and sent back to the TNAI Headquarters by October 31, 2019.

(vi) SNA Unit Obtaining Maximum Prizes at the Biennial Conference

This award is given to the SNA Unit, which receives the maximum number of prizes for the various competitions held during the SNA Conference.

a. Group Items

- First Prize : 10 Points
- Second Prize : 7 Points
- Third Prize : 5 Points

b. Individual Items

First Prize : 5 Points

Second Prize : 3 Points

Third Prize : 1 Point

The unit receiving the maximum number of points will be considered as a winner.

B. Criteria for the Competitions

01. Scientific Paper Presentation: The Student Nurse(s) will present the Scientific Paper on theme **“Nursing: Harmony of mind, body and spirit”** during the SNA Biennial Conference.

- (i) The paper should contain Introduction, Need and significance in Nursing, Statement of the Problem, Objectives, Review of Literature, Brief description of Methods and Procedures, Findings and Interpretation to be placed in one or two tables, Recommendation, Conclusion and Bibliography.
- (ii) One hard copy and soft copy in CD of the Scientific Paper containing not more than 1500 words (4-5 pages in A-4 size) should be submitted to the State SNA Advisor by 31 July 2019, before the State SNA Conference of the respective State.
- (iii) The State SNA Advisor should select **one best Scientific Paper at the State Level** and forward the same to the TNAI Headquarters by 31 August 2019 for final evaluation at national level.

The Best three papers, selected by the TNAI Headquarters will be intimated to the State SNA Advisor, the respective SNA Unit, presenter for the presentation during the SNA Conference 2019. The selected candidate will be provided 2nd class rail fare (to and fro) to the student who presenting the paper. In addition to that Rs.200/- will be paid as DA to her/his.

02. Best SNA Unit Award

As per criteria, cash awards will be given to 3 best SNA units based on their performance. I prize - Rs.25,000/-; II prize - Rs.15,000/- and III prize - Rs.10,000/-; award will be given during the National SNA Biennial Conference 2019.

The criteria for the award are as follows:

- Year of establishment of the SNA Unit.
- Continuous renewal of units without any break by paying the SNA subscriptions regularly to the National level in time.
- Number of SNA conferences attended by the unit at State and National level.
- Number of Awards received at the National conference.
- Submission of SNA Diary at both State and National level.
- Enrollment of SNA to TNAI members every year.
- Number of students having participated in the National level Conference from the SNA Unit.

The above criteria is applicable to scrutinize at the state level and will be routed through the State SNA Advisor. Only one best SNA unit will be nominated by the State to TNAI Headquarters. The TNAI Headquarters will select best 3 (three) SNA units for the award.

Note: Decisions were taken at the Executive, Council meeting of TNAI held at Guntur, Andhra Pradesh during November 29th to December 3rd, 2017.

03. Biennial SNA Diary Evaluation for (2017 & 2018)

(i) Unit Level: SNA units should record the activities and to be signed by the unit SNA Secretary and unit SNA Advisor and the same to be forward to the State SNA Advisor for evaluation by 31 July 2019.

Since 1988 [Minute No. SNA-GC/18/88/3(i)], Diary of ANM Schools are evaluated separately. Send separate Diary for ANM schools from each unit to state level.

(ii) State Level: After receiving the SNA Diary from each unit it should be evaluated at the State level. The State SNA Advisor should write his/her remarks with seal and signature and two outstanding diaries from each State should be sent to the TNAI Headquarters by 31 August 2019 for final evaluation.

Criteria: These diaries are assessed keeping in view the various unit activities, viz., professional, educational, extra-curricular, social, cultural and recreational. Proper maintenance of diary is another criterion. In general the focus of assessment is on the diversity of activities carried out by the units as reflected in the Diary.SNA to TNAI membership enrollment for two years.

Note: As the SNA Diary of ANM students are evaluated separately each state are requested to send two diaries one for ANM unit and other Diary for GNM/B.Sc.(N).

04. Poster Presentation

The criteria for Poster Presentation

Size: Standard size (22"x26") approx. for both individual and group poster presentation.

Topics: Ideas depicted in the poster should be relevant to the topics given above. Lettering and design of the poster should be bold and big enough to be seen from distance.

Clarity: For bringing clarity of the poster, restrict yourself to one idea relevant to the topic.

Layout of pictures in the poster must be properly balanced to give a correct sense of proportion.

No Extra fixing of clippings/cuttings or any other form on the poster.

The poster should depict originality with innovative ideas.

- f. History and culture

Note: video or pictures can be included in any of the rounds

(ii) **General Rules**

- a. Direct questions will get 10 marks.
- b. Pass on questions will get 5 marks.
- c. Direct questions will have 30 seconds for answering and no extra time will be allowed for pass on questions.
- d. First answer from each team will be entertained.
- e. Scorer will be there and score will be displayed on a board.
- f. The decision of the Quiz masters at the National level will be the final.

Six Teams/ 3 members per team

(iii) **Rounds**

- a. Preliminary Round for all – 25 MCQ questions
- b. 30 minutes will be given – Put tick mark () against correct answer.

06. Essay Competition: Only one individual entry **either in Hindi or English** will be permitted **from each State**. The topic will be given just before the commencement of the competition. Words limit is 1000. Candidate can write in Hindi or English. Evaluation is done by 3 experts. Time allotted will be one hour.

Criteria for Evaluation: Introduction; Relevance to the Topic; Organization of the content (Grammar, Language, Vocabulary, Spelling); Use of Examples and Current Trends; Implications; Conclusion.

07. Extempore Speech:

Criteria:

- (i) One entry from each state, *either English or Hindi*.
- (ii) Separate prizes for Hindi and English
- (iii) Maximum time is 03 minutes
- (iv) Topics will be given on the spot

- 08. Sports:** The events are: 100 Meters Race/ Discus throw and Javelin throw. Competitions for these events will be held separately for **male and female contestants**. The entries selected at the state level are to be sent by the State SNA Advisor to the TNAI Headquarters for national level competition.
- 09. On-the-Spot Painting:** The topic will be announced just before the competition. Only one individual entry will be permitted from each State. Participants should bring their own painting materials, the organisers will provide only chart paper. No Mechanical devices, e.g. use of stencils, etc. will be permitted. Time allotted will be **One Hour**.
- 010. Pencil Sketch:** The topic will be announced just before the competition. Only one individual entry will be permitted from each State. Participants should bring their own materials, the organisers will provide only chart paper. No Mechanical devices, e.g. use of stencils, etc. will be permitted. Time allotted will be **One Hour**.
- 011. Floor Decoration (Rangoli):** Theme/Topic will be given on the spot. Only one individual entry will be permitted from each State. Participants should bring their own material. No mechanical devices e.g., use of stencils etc. will be allowed. The size is 3x3 feet. Time allotted for Rangoli will be **one Hour**.
- 012. Mono acting :** Scenario or situation will be given on the spot. Only one individual entry will be permitted from each State. Medium of expression can be English or Hindi. Time allotted for mono acting will be **5 minutes**.
- 013. Personality Contest:** As per the Minute No.SNA/G.C./37/2007/5 (ii) **Mr. and Ms. SNA** Beauty Pageant Competition has been renamed as "Personality Contest". The best entries (one female and one male) selected at the state level are to be sent by the State SNA Advisor to the TNAI Headquarters for national level competition.
- 014. Talent Night:** Each State will be given one item for presentation at the national level. Only **one** best folk (or) classical dance either individual or group (not more than 8 members) from each State will be accepted for competition at the national level. Time: **3 Minutes** for Classical and **7 minutes** for Folk Dance.

Benefits of SNA Membership

- 1.SNA Scholarship: Awarding scholarship to the students of ANM/GNM and B.sc program. The selected candidates are awarded Rs. 24000/- per year for the entire training period after reviewing their performance every year.
2. No Scholarship application fee
3. No competition fee in National conference
4. Participation in State and National workshops and conferences: concession in the registration fee for SNA members and are given chance to present scientific papers on the theme and to participate in all competitions.
5. Publication of articles: The student nurses are given an opportunity in the Nursing Journal of India to publish articles/research papers.
6. TNAI Publication to SNA units: A set of TNAI Nursing text books, Nursing Journal of India and TNAI Bulletin are supplied to all Student Nurses Association (SNA) Units at free of cost.
- 7.Guest room facilities: Accommodation for SNA members are provided in the TNAI Headquarters and in TNAI's Greater Noida campus at reasonable rate of Rs.250/- per student/day.

New SNA - TNAI Membership plan

As per the SNA - TNAI membership plan which is applicable from 2016-2017 academic year each student is required to make onetime payment of Rs 2000/- at the time of admission. This payment is inclusive of SNA subscription for 4 years, scholarship fund and SNA to TNAI Membership.

The merits of the new plan are:

1. The students need not pay SNA subscription fee and scholarship fund every year and Rs.2200/ student after completion of the course.
2. Once she/he completes the course she/he will become a TNAI member automatically.

- The TNAI Membership Cards will be issued to them after a copy of their State Nurses registration council certificates (RNRM) or letter from the Principal of the respective School/ College of Nursing along with final year mark sheet to be submitted to TNAI.
- The ANM students are required to pay Rs. 1000/- at the time of admission inclusive of SNA subscription for 2 years, scholarship fund and SNA to Associate membership of TNAI.

Old Plan

The students adopting old plan need to pay SNA subscription of Rs. 150/- per student per year and Rs. 2200/- for SNA to TNAI membership fee after their successful completion of their course.

Note:

- Every SNA Unit should remit the SNA Subscription fees for the academic year 2018 – 2019 before 31st March 2019.
- Those who did not pay the SNA subscription for the academic year 2017 – 2018 and 2018-2019 may not be allowed to participate in the state as well as national XXVIII SNA Biennial Conference 2019.


